1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the designation of a portion of Interstate Highway 10 as
1-22 the U.S. Border Patrol Agent Rogelio Martinez Memorial Highway.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
1-25 is amended by adding Section 225.190 to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 225.190. U.S. BORDER PATROL AGENT ROGELIO MARTINEZ
1-27 MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a) The portion of Interstate Highway 10 in
1-28 Culberson County between mile marker 150 and mile marker 155 is
1-29 designated as the U.S. Border Patrol Agent Rogelio Martinez
1-30 Memorial Highway. The designation is in addition to any other
1-31 designation.

1-32 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-33 (1) design and construct markers indicating the
1-34 designation as the U.S. Border Patrol Agent Rogelio Martinez
1-35 Memorial Highway and any other appropriate information; and

1-36 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
1-37 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-38 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
