(c-3) Beginning with the 2022-2023 school year, the minimum monthly salary that a school district must pay each classroom teacher under Subsection (c-2) is adjusted annually to increase the 16 17 minimum monthly salary by the amount that results from applying the inflation rate, as determined by the comptroller on the basis of 18 changes in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers 19 published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States 20 21 Department of Labor, to the minimum monthly salary required under Subsection (c-2) for the preceding school year.
