- SECTION 1. Section 124.062, Election Code, is amended by 4 5 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 6 (d) Each electronic system ballot must contain a serial number that must be printed before insertion in a ballot marking 7 device, if any. The secretary of state may not waive this

VOTING SYSTEM BALLOTS. (a) The secretary of state shall approve

- 13 secretary of state may not waive this requirement after September

- SECTION 4. Subchapter C, Chapter 125, Election Code, is
- 16 amended by adding Section 125.0621 to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 125.0621. LOGS OF ISSUED AND SPOILED BALLOTS. If an
- 18 electronic voting system uses paper media for recording votes cast,
- 19 the election officer shall maintain a record of the serial numbers
- 20 of all ballots issued at that polling place and the serial numbers
- 21 of any spoiled ballots, if any.
- 22 SECTION 5. Section 125.063, Election Code, is amended to
- 23 read as follows:
- Sec. 125.063. SECURING EQUIPMENT ON CLOSE OF VOTING. (a)
- 25 On the close of voting at each polling place at which electronic
- 26 voting system equipment is used, an election officer shall secure
- 27 or inactivate the equipment as prescribed by the secretary of state
