1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to designating September 21 as Alzheimer's Awareness Day.
1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-19 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 662, Government Code, is
1-20 amended by adding Section 662.083 to read as follows:
1-21 Sec. 662.083. ALZHEIMER'S AWARENESS DAY. (a) September 21
1-22 is Alzheimer's Awareness Day to increase awareness of individuals
1-23 who are suffering from dementia and to express appreciation to the
1-24 caregivers of Alzheimer's patients for the services and care
1-25 provided to the patients.
1-26 (b) Alzheimer's Awareness Day shall be regularly observed
1-27 by appropriate programs and activities.
1-28 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
