- Sec. 217.901. REGULATION OF SOUND FROM CERTAIN VENUES IN 10
- CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES PROHIBITED. (a) This section applies only 11
- 12 to a municipality with a population of 750,000 or more that is
- primarily located in a county with a population of 1.5 million or 13
- 14 less.

- (b) A municipality may not adopt or enforce an ordinance 15
- that regulates the production of amplified sound from a bar if the 16
- sound is produced: 17
- (1) from a loudspeaker or sound amplifier at a level 18
- that does not exceed 85 decibels; and 19
- (2) at any time between the hours of 10 a.m. and 2 a.m. 20
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
