- 2 (c) Annually, the commission shall submit to the
- 3 <u>legislature</u> a report regarding critical load premises
- 4 designations, including analysis of the implementation and results
- 5 of the designations.
- 6 SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2022, the Public
- 7 Utility Commission of Texas shall submit to the legislature the
- 8 first report required by Section 38.074, Utilities Code, as added
- 9 by this Act.
- 10 SECTION 3. If this Act takes effect immediately, the Public
- 11 Utility Commission of Texas shall adopt the rules required by
- 12 Section 38.074, Utilities Code, as added by this Act, not later than
- 13 September 1, 2021. If this Act takes effect September 1, 2021, the
- 14 Public Utility Commission of Texas shall adopt rules as required by
- 15 Section 38.074, Utilities Code, as added by this Act, not later than
- 16 November 1, 2021.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
