A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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2	relating to health benefits offered by certain nonprofit
3	agricultural organizations.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. The heading to Subtitle K, Title 8, Insurance
6	Code, is amended to read as follows:
7	SUBTITLE K. CERTAIN BENEFITS AND ARRANGEMENTS THAT ARE NOT
8	INSURANCE [HEALTH CARE SHARING MINISTRIES]
9	SECTION 2. Subtitle K, Title 8, Insurance Code, is amended
10	by adding Chapter 1682 to read as follows:
11	CHAPTER 1682. HEALTH BENEFITS PROVIDED BY CERTAIN NONPROFIT
12	AGRICULTURAL ORGANIZATIONS
13	Sec. 1682.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
14	(1) "Nonprofit agricultural organization" means an
15	organization that:
16	(A) is exempt from taxation under Section 501(a),
17	Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as an organization described by
18	<pre>Section 501(c)(5) of that code;</pre>
19	(B) is domiciled in this state;
20	(C) was in existence prior to 1940;
21	(D) is composed of members who are residents of
22	at least 98 percent of the counties in this state;
23	(E) collects annual dues from its members; and
24	(F) was created to promote and develop the most

- 1 profitable and desirable system of agriculture and the most
- 2 wholesome and satisfactory conditions of rural life in accordance
- 3 with its articles of organization and bylaws.
- 4 (2) "Nonprofit agricultural organization health
- 5 benefits" means health benefits:
- 6 (A) sponsored by a nonprofit agricultural
- 7 organization or an affiliate of the organization;
- 8 <u>(B) offered only to:</u>
- 9 (i) members of the nonprofit agricultural
- 10 organization; and
- 11 (ii) family members of members of the
- 12 nonprofit agricultural organization;
- 13 (C) that are not provided through an insurance
- 14 policy or other product the offering or issuance of which
- 15 constitutes the business of insurance in this state; and
- 16 (D) that are deemed by the nonprofit agricultural
- 17 organization to be important in assisting its members to live long
- 18 and productive lives.
- 19 (3) "Preexisting condition" means a condition present
- 20 before the effective date of an individual's enrollment in
- 21 nonprofit agricultural organization health benefits.
- Sec. 1682.002. NONPROFIT AGRICULTURAL ORGANIZATION HEALTH
- 23 BENEFITS AUTHORIZED. A nonprofit agricultural organization or an
- 24 affiliate of the organization may offer in this state nonprofit
- 25 agricultural organization health benefits.
- Sec. 1682.003. WAITING PERIOD FOR PREEXISTING CONDITION.
- 27 Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, a nonprofit

- 1 agricultural organization that offers nonprofit agricultural
- 2 organization health benefits may not require a waiting period of
- 3 more than six months for treatment of a preexisting condition
- 4 otherwise included in nonprofit agricultural organization health
- 5 benefits.
- 6 Sec. 1682.004. REQUIRED DISCLOSURE BY NONPROFIT
- 7 AGRICULTURAL ORGANIZATION. (a) A nonprofit agricultural
- 8 organization that offers nonprofit agricultural organization
- 9 health benefits must provide to an individual applying for
- 10 nonprofit agricultural organization health benefits written notice
- 11 that the benefits are not provided through an insurance policy or
- 12 other product the offering or issuance of which is regulated as the
- 13 business of insurance in this state.
- 14 (b) An individual must sign and return to the nonprofit
- 15 agricultural organization the notice described by Subsection (a)
- 16 before the individual may enroll in nonprofit agricultural
- 17 organization health benefits. The nonprofit agricultural
- 18 organization must:
- 19 (1) maintain a copy of the signed written notice for
- 20 the duration of the term during which the nonprofit agricultural
- 21 organization health benefits are provided to the individual; and
- 22 (2) at the request of the individual, provide a copy of
- 23 the written notice to the individual.
- Sec. 1682.005. NONPROFIT AGRICULTURAL ORGANIZATION NOT
- 25 ENGAGED IN BUSINESS OF INSURANCE. Notwithstanding any other
- 26 provision of this code, for the purposes of offering nonprofit
- 27 agricultural organization health benefits, a nonprofit

- 1 agricultural organization that acts in accordance with this chapter
- 2 is not an insurer and is not engaging in the business of insurance
- 3 in this state.
- 4 Sec. 1682.006. RISK TRANSFER OR COVERAGE. A nonprofit
- 5 agricultural organization that offers nonprofit agricultural
- 6 organization health benefits under this chapter may contract with a
- 7 company authorized to engage in the business of insurance in this
- 8 state that is not under common control with the nonprofit
- 9 agricultural organization to:
- 10 (1) transfer to that company all or a portion of the
- 11 organization's risks arising from nonprofit agricultural
- 12 organization health benefits offered under this chapter; or
- 13 (2) obtain insurance coverage from the company
- 14 guarantying the nonprofit agricultural organization's obligations
- 15 <u>arising from nonprofit agricultural organization health benefits</u>
- 16 <u>offered under this chapter.</u>
- Sec. 1682.007. APPLICABILITY OF CERTAIN LAWS TO NONPROFIT
- 18 AGRICULTURAL ORGANIZATION HEALTH BENEFITS. Notwithstanding
- 19 Section 1682.004, a nonprofit agricultural organization that
- 20 offers nonprofit agricultural organization health benefits that
- 21 are determined by the commissioner to be structured in the manner of
- 22 a preferred provider benefit plan or an exclusive provider benefit
- 23 plan, as those terms are defined by Section 1301.001, is subject to
- 24 the following laws and rules as if the nonprofit agricultural
- 25 organization were an insurer, individuals entitled to nonprofit
- 26 agricultural organization health benefits were insureds, and the
- 27 nonprofit agricultural organization health benefits were provided

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through an insurance policy subject to Chapter 1301:
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               (1) Section 1301.005;
               (2) Section 1301.0053;
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               (3) Section 1301.0055;
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               (4) Section 1301.006;
               (5) Section 1301.010;
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               (6) <u>Section 1301.155;</u>
               (7) Section 1301.164;
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               (8) Section 1301.165;
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               (9) Chapter 1467; and
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               (10) 28 T.A.C. Chapter 3, Subchapter X.
          SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
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
