4	SECTION 1. Title 2, Agriculture Code, is amended by adding
5	Chapter 23 to read as follows:
6	CHAPTER 23. SANITARY TRANSPORTATION OF HUMAN AND ANIMAL FOOD
7	Sec. 23.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "commercial
8	motor vehicle" has the meaning assigned by Section 644.001,
9	Transportation Code.
10	Sec. 23.002. RULES. (a) The department by rule shall adopt
11	standards for the sanitary transportation of human and animal food
12	by a commercial motor vehicle.
13	(b) Standards adopted under this section must:
14	(1) be consistent with rules adopted by the Department
15	of Public Safety under Section 644.055, Transportation Code; and
16	(2) comply with the Food Safety Modernization Act (21
17	U.S.C. Section 2201 et seq.).
18	Sec. 23.003. CERTIFIED CLEANING. (a) The department shall

- sanitization of commercial motor vehicles used to transport human 20

- 22 (b) A person certified under this section shall keep a
- 23 record of each commercial motor vehicle sanitized in a form

- 1 (c) The operator of a commercial motor vehicle used for the
- 2 transportation of human or animal food shall keep with the vehicle a
- 3 record of each sanitization under this section.
- 4 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 644, Transportation Code,
- 5 is amended by adding Section 644.055 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 644.055. REGULATION OF VEHICLES TRANSPORTING HUMAN OR
- 7 ANIMAL FOOD. The department shall adopt rules for the inspection of
- 8 a commercial motor vehicle transporting human or animal food to
- 9 ensure compliance with the rules adopted by the Department of
- 10 Agriculture under Section 23.002, Agriculture Code. Rules adopted
- 11 under this section must be consistent with those rules.
- 12 SECTION 3. (a) Not later than January 1, 2022, the Texas
- 13 Department of Agriculture shall adopt rules under Chapter 23,
- 14 Agriculture Code, as added by this Act.
- 15 (b) Not later than January 1, 2022, the Department of Public
- 16 Safety shall adopt rules under Section 644.055, Transportation
- 17 Code, as added by this Act.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
