- 2 relating to the modification of a disposition by a juvenile court
- 3 after a child's violation of a condition of probation.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 54.05, Family Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Subsection (n) to read as follows:
- 7 (n) If a court finds after a hearing to modify disposition
- 8 that a child violated a condition of probation by engaging in
- 9 conduct that does not violate a penal law of this state, the court
- 10 may not modify the disposition by ordering the placement of the
- 11 child in a juvenile facility solely because of the violation unless
- 12 the conduct indicates that the child may be dangerous to the child's
- 13 <u>self or may threaten the safety of the public.</u>
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 54.05(n), Family Code, as added by this
- 15 Act, applies only to conduct that occurs on or after September 1,
- 16 2021. Conduct that occurred before September 1, 2021, is governed
- $17\,$ by the law in effect on the date the conduct occurred, and the
- 18 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 19 this section, conduct occurred before September 1, 2021, if any
- 20 element of the conduct occurred before that date.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
