 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to applicability of civil service status to emergency
 1-20 medical services personnel in certain municipalities.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 143.401(a), Local Government Code, is
 1-23 amended to read as follows:

1-24 (a) This subchapter applies only to a municipality:

1-25 (1) with a population of 460,000 or more that:
 1-26 (A) operates under a city manager form of
 1-27 government; or

1-28 (B) operated under a city manager form of
 1-29 government at the time this subchapter was adopted in the
 1-30 municipality; and

1-31 (2) that employs emergency medical services personnel
 1-32 in a municipal department other than the fire department.

1-33 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-34 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-35 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-36 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-37 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
