- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. DEFINITION. In this Act, "committee" means the committee established under Section 2 of this Act. 6
- 7 SECTION 2. COMMITTEE. (a) The committee is composed of 76 members as follows: 8
- 9 (1) one member appointed by the governor who serves as presiding officer of the committee; 10
- 11 (2) one member appointed jointly by the lieutenant governor and the speaker of the house of representatives who serves
- as vice presiding officer; 13
- 14 (3) two members appointed by each senator:
- both of whom must be residents of the 15 16 senator's district;
- one of whom must be male and the other female; 17 (B)
- 18 (C) one of whom must be:
- (i) a member of a county historical 19
- 20 commission or local historical society in the senator's district
- 21 and recommended by the commission or society, if there is at least
- one county historical commission or local historical society in the 22
- 23 district; or

24 (ii) otherwise recommended by a county

- 1 commissioners court in the senator's district as knowledgeable on
- 2 local history; and
- 3 (D) one of whom must be selected after soliciting
- 4 input from each county judge in the senator's district on the
- 5 proposed member;
- 6 (4) four members appointed by the chair of the Texas
- 7 Legislative Black Caucus in consultation with the members of the
- 8 caucus;
- 9 (5) four members appointed by the chair of the Mexican
- 10 American Legislative Caucus in consultation with the members of the
- 11 caucus;
- 12 (6) one member appointed by the commissioner of the
- 13 General Land Office to represent that office;
- 14 (7) one member appointed by the comptroller to
- 15 represent the comptroller's office;
- 16 (8) one member appointed by the executive director of
- 17 the Texas Historical Commission to represent that commission; and
- 18 (9) one member appointed by the executive director of
- 19 the Texas Commission on the Arts to represent that commission.
- 20 (b) The committee must reflect the racial, ethnic, and
- 21 geographic diversity of this state.
- (c) The committee shall meet at the call of the presiding
- 23 officer. Committee meetings may be held in-person, by telephone,
- 24 or by other means of communication.
- 25 (d) The committee may establish subcommittees to assist the
- 26 committee in carrying out its duties under this Act.
- (e) A member of the committee may not receive compensation

- 1 for service on the committee.
- 2 (f) The General Land Office and the Texas Historical
- 3 Commission shall provide administrative support services at the
- 4 request of the committee, including assisting in drafting and
- 5 compiling the report required by this Act.
- 6 (g) Committee meetings must be open to the public.
- 7 SECTION 3. STUDY; REPORT. (a) The committee shall study
- 8 the formation of a Texas Bicentennial Commission to plan this
- 9 state's celebration of the 2036 bicentennial, including:
- 10 (1) the composition of the commission, the manner of
- 11 appointing its members, and the total number of members; and
- 12 (2) the scope and duties of the commission.
- 13 (b) Not later than December 30, 2022, the committee shall
- 14 submit a written report to each member of the legislature with
- 15 recommendations on the areas of study described by Subsection (a)
- 16 of this section and any other recommendations the committee
- 17 considers appropriate.
- 18 SECTION 4. EXPIRATION. The committee is abolished and this
- 19 Act expires January 1, 2023.
- 20 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect September
- 21 1, 2021.
