## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to a transfer of ownership for a perpetual care cemetery.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 712, Health and Safety
5	Code, is amended by adding Section 712.00391 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 712.00391. TRANSFER OF BUSINESS OWNERSHIP; DUTIES OF
7	NEW CERTIFICATE HOLDER. (a) In this section, "transferor" means a
8	certificate holder who transfers the holder's ownership of a
9	perpetual care cemetery to another person.
10	(b) On the transfer of the business ownership of a perpetual
11	care cemetery, the new certificate holder may not modify the terms,
12	including the amount of any fees for maintenance or upkeep of the
13	cemetery, of a prepaid funeral contract entered into by the plot
14	owner and the transferor without the plot owner's agreement.
15	(c) Not later than 60 days after the date a transfer of
16	ownership of a perpetual care cemetery described by Section
17	712.0039(b) is executed, the new certificate holder shall:
18	(1) notify each plot owner:
19	(A) of the transfer of ownership and the identity
20	of the new certificate holder; and
21	(B) that the new certificate holder may not
22	modify the terms of a prepaid funeral contract entered into by the
23	plot owner and the transferor; and
2/1	(2) provide the costs outlined in the prepaid funeral

- 1 contract entered into by the plot owner and the transferor.
- 2 (d) During a transfer of ownership and for at least 120 days
- 3 following the transfer, a perpetual care cemetery must have a
- 4 representative available to provide assistance to a plot owner or
- 5 the owner's immediate family members or authorized representative.
- 6 The assistance must be provided in English and Spanish or, if
- 7 applicable, English and any other language spoken by a substantial
- 8 portion of the individuals residing in the area in which the
- 9 perpetual care cemetery is located.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 712.00391, Health and Safety Code, as
- 11 added by this Act, applies to a transfer in business ownership of a
- 12 perpetual care cemetery that occurs on or after the effective date
- 13 of this Act. A transfer in business ownership that occurs before
- 14 that date is governed by the law in effect on the date the transfer
- 15 occurred, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
