## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

Τ	AN ACT
2	relating to pregnancy resource center reporting requirements.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subtitle H, Title 2, Health and Safety Code, is
5	amended by adding Chapter 174 to read as follows:
6	CHAPTER 174. PREGNANCY RESOURCE CENTERS
7	Sec. 174.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "pregnancy
8	resource center" means an organization, including a pregnancy
9	counseling organization, crisis pregnancy center, pregnancy care
10	center, or pregnancy support center, that for a fee or free of
11	charge provides pregnancy counseling or information but:
12	(1) does not perform abortions or make referrals to an
13	abortion provider;
14	(2) does not provide or make referrals for
15	comprehensive birth control services;
16	(3) is not licensed or certified by this state or the
17	federal government to provide medical or health care services; and
18	(4) is not required to have a physician under contract
19	to provide or directly supervise all health care services provided
20	by the organization.
21	Sec. 174.002. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS. (a) Each pregnancy
22	resource center shall submit a monthly report to the commission
23	containing information on each patient receiving services provided
24	by the center. The report must be submitted on the form prescribed

- 1 by the commission and made available on the commission's Internet
- 2 website.
- 3 (b) The report must include:
- 4 (1) the licensing status of the center;
- 5 (2) each patient's year of birth, race, marital
- 6 status, and county and state of residence;
- 7 (3) the type of services provided;
- 8 <u>(4) the date the services were provided;</u>
- 9 (5) the probable post-fertilization age of the unborn
- 10 child based on the best judgment of the attending physician or other
- 11 health care practitioner at the time services were provided;
- 12 (6) the date, if known, of each patient's last
- 13 menstrual cycle;
- 14 (7) the number of previous live births of each
- 15 patient; and
- 16 (8) the number of previous induced abortions of each
- 17 patient, if applicable.
- 18 (c) Not later than the 15th day of each month, the pregnancy
- 19 resource center shall submit to the commission the report required
- 20 by this section for each person receiving services provided by the
- 21 <u>center in the preceding calendar month.</u>
- 22 <u>(d) The commission shall provide the information submitted</u>
- 23 under this section biannually in a report to the members of the
- 24 legislature.
- (e) The commission shall remove the name, birth date, and
- 26 any other personal identifying information of a patient from a
- 27 report submitted under Subsection (d).

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- 1 (f) A pregnancy resource center or health care practitioner
- 2 that violates this section is subject to disciplinary action by the
- 3 state agency that regulates the center or practitioner as if the
- 4 center or practitioner had violated the applicable licensing law.
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
