CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, Closing public beaches during the COVID-19 pandemic
- 2 proved challenging in coastal communities due to the uncertainty of
- 3 who determines the boundaries of public beaches, who enforces the
- 4 law governing access to public beaches, and who has the authority to
- 5 close access to public beaches during a disaster; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Public beaches are a shared responsibility of the
- 7 state and local governments, and clarifying their jurisdictions
- 8 would help to ensure that safety protocols are enforced; now,
- 9 therefore, be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the 87th Legislature of the State of Texas
- 11 hereby request that the lieutenant governor and the speaker of the
- 12 house of representatives create a joint interim committee to study
- 13 the determination of the boundaries of, and the enforcement of the
- 14 law governing access to, public beaches and the authority of a
- 15 county or municipality to close access to public beaches during a
- 16 disaster; and, be it further
- 17 RESOLVED, That the committee's proceedings and operations be
- 18 governed by such general rules and policies for interim committees
- 19 as the 87th Texas Legislature may adopt; and, be it further
- 20 RESOLVED, That the committee shall submit a full report,
- 21 including findings and recommendations, to the 88th Texas
- 22 Legislature in January 2023.
