CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1           WHEREAS, Family and friends will forever treasure their  
2 memories of Brandon Keith White of Fort Davis, who died on August 8,  
3 2020, at the age of 52; and

4           WHEREAS, Born in Lubbock to Ronnie and Glenda White on  
5 December 7, 1967, Brandon White grew up in Spur with two younger  
6 brothers, Cody and Lance; he was a talented rodeo rider in his  
7 youth, winning many ribbons with his horse, Snapper; after  
8 graduating from Spur High School in 1986, he briefly attended Sul  
9 Ross State University; and

10           WHEREAS, Mr. White spent his career throughout West Texas,  
11 including Alpine, Marfa, and Fort Davis, and he proved himself to be  
12 a man of many talents; over the years, he worked as a home builder  
13 and a furniture maker, and he also ran a hotel, a pizza parlor, a car  
14 wash, and a gym, as well as roofing, construction, and  
15 air-conditioning businesses; moreover, he was employed with South  
16 Plains Electric Cooperative, and since 2016, he had been a Texas  
17 Parks and Wildlife Department technician at the Elephant Mountain  
18 Wildlife Management Area, where he played a vital role in the  
19 preservation of the populations of bighorn and pronghorn sheep; and

20           WHEREAS, Above all else, Mr. White was devoted to his family;  
21 he shared a rewarding relationship with his wife, Leticia, and he  
22 took great pride in his children, Cortnee and Ryder, and his  
23 stepchildren, Ashley and Wesley; and

24           WHEREAS, Brandon White lived life to the fullest, and

1 although his journey on this earth ended far too soon, memories of  
2 his passionate and generous nature remain to comfort all those who  
3 knew and loved him; now, therefore, be it

4         RESOLVED, That the 87th Legislature of the State of Texas  
5 hereby pay tribute to the memory of Brandon Keith White and extend  
6 heartfelt sympathy to the members of his family: to his parents,
