A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to prohibit the governor from
- 2 regulating alcoholic beverages, firearms, explosives, or
- 3 combustibles by order or proclamation.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article IV, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 27 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 27. The Governor may not, by order or proclamation,
- 8 suspend or limit the sale, dispensing, or transportation of
- 9 <u>alcoholic beverages</u>, firearms, explosives, or combustibles,
- 10 regardless of whether this State is in a period of emergency
- 11 resulting from a disaster.
- 12 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 13 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 2, 2021.
- 14 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 15 proposition: "The constitutional amendment prohibiting the
- 16 governor from regulating alcoholic beverages, firearms,
- 17 explosives, or combustibles by order or proclamation."
