A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment requiring the state to expand
- 2 eligibility for Medicaid to all persons for whom federal matching

- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 74 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 74. The state shall provide medical assistance under
- 8 the federal Medicaid program to all persons who apply for that
- 9 assistance and for whom federal matching money is available.
- 10 SECTION 2. The following temporary provision is added to
- 11 the Texas Constitution:
- 12 TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a) This temporary provision applies
- 13 to the constitutional amendment proposed by the 87th Legislature,
- 14 Regular Session, 2021, requiring the state to expand eligibility
- 15 for Medicaid to all persons for whom federal matching money is
- 16 available.
- 17 (b) Section 74, Article XVI, of this constitution takes
- 18 effect January 1, 2022.
- (c) This temporary provision expires January 1, 2023.
- 20 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 21 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 2, 2021.
- 22 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
- 23 proposition: "The constitutional amendment requiring the state to
- 24 expand eligibility for Medicaid to all persons for whom federal
