1-17 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

1-18 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing a county to
 1-19 finance the development or redevelopment of transportation or
 1-20 infrastructure in unproductive, underdeveloped, or blighted areas
 1-21 in the county; authorizing the issuance of bonds and notes.

1-22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Section 1-g(b), Article VIII, Texas
 1-24 Constitution, is amended to read as follows:

1-25 (b) The legislature by general law may authorize a county or
 1-26 an incorporated city or town to issue bonds or notes to finance the
 1-27 development or redevelopment of an unproductive, underdeveloped,
 1-28 or blighted area within the county, city, or town and to pledge for
 1-29 repayment of those bonds or notes increases in ad valorem tax
 1-30 revenues imposed on property in the area by the county, city, or
 1-31 town and other political subdivisions.

1-32 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
 1-33 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 2, 2021.
 1-34 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
 1-35 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing a county to
 1-36 finance the development or redevelopment of transportation or
 1-37 infrastructure in unproductive, underdeveloped, or blighted areas
 1-38 in the county."

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
