1 WHEREAS, Family and friends will long cherish their memories
2 of Pamela Kay Jones Acton of Ozona, who passed away on October 24,
3 2020, at the age of 77; and

4 WHEREAS, The former Pam Jones was born in San Angelo on
5 November 29, 1942, to William and Esther Jones and was raised on
6 family ranches in Crockett County; she shared a rewarding marriage
7 with her husband, Earl Acton, that spanned more than four decades
8 until his death in 2007, and she took great pride in her two
9 children, Bobbie Renfroe and the late Marty Acton; with the passing
10 years, Mrs. Acton had the pleasure of seeing her family grow to
11 include two grandchildren and two great-grandchildren; and

12 WHEREAS, Passionate about ranching, Mrs. Acton raised and
13 showed registered Rambouillet sheep and was one of the first women
14 to compete in team roping in the Professional Rodeo Cowboys
15 Association; among her other accomplishments, she represented
16 Crockett County at the National 4-H Congress in Chicago, and she
17 served as president of the Devils River Ranchers Protective
18 Association and as a director of the Texas High School Rodeo
19 Association and the Ozona-Barnhart Trap Company; in addition she
20 was a skilled markswoman and renowned for her ability to fix
21 anything; and

22 WHEREAS, Mrs. Acton was also a longtime member of the Ozona
23 United Methodist Church and served on its hospitality committee;
24 moreover, she helped to create and oversee the church services at

1 the San Angelo Cinch Roping Fiesta and the San Angelo Stock Show &
2 Rodeo; and

3 WHEREAS, Pam Acton lived a life that was rich in personal and
4 professional achievements, and she will forever be a source of
5 inspiration to those she leaves behind; now, therefore, be it

6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas
7 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the memory of Pamela Kay Jones
8 Acton and extend heartfelt sympathy to the members of her family: to
9 her daughter, Bobbie Renfroe, and her husband, Billy; to her

11 and her husband, Sean; to her great-grandchildren, Wyatt Tate and
