2 a close with the passing of Jerry Lynn Bell of Leona on January 10,  
3 2021, at the age of 77; and

4           WHEREAS, A native of Leon County, Jerry Bell was born in  
5 Russell on May 2, 1943, to William and Mary Bell; he was raised with  
6 the companionship of nine siblings, Wendell, Weldon, Frank, Cecil,  
7 Wallace Ray, Roy, Mayme Pearl, Eva Ruth, and Mary Jo; and

8           WHEREAS, Mr. Bell joined the U.S. Army and served with  
9 distinction as a tanker and helicopter gunner during the Vietnam  
10 War, receiving a number of commendations; he was stationed around

14 the owner and operator of Bell Alley Gunsmithing; there, he spent  
15 his days doing what he loved most, selling firearms and discussing

18           WHEREAS, A devoted family man, Mr. Bell shared a rewarding  
19 marriage with his wife, Alice, and he took great pride in his four  
20 children, Jerry, Harold, Kimberly, and Wendy, and his nine
