9 licensed, she opened a family law practice to provide low-cost and
10 pro bono legal services to clients unable to afford private

13 assistant disciplinary counsel for the State Bar of Texas, and she
14 went on to further her professional reputation as a regional
15 attorney for the State Department of Family and Protective
