R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, A full and generous life drew to a close with the
2 passing of Bob Charles Dunn of Nacogdoches on September 3, 2019, at
3 the age of 89; and

4 WHEREAS, Bob Dunn was born at home in Titus County on January
5 25, 1930, to Ophus and Emma Dunn; following his graduation from
6 Mount Pleasant High School, he served in the U.S. Air Force for four
7 years and then went on to earn a business degree from North Texas
8 State College in 1958; and

9 WHEREAS, Dedicated to his community, Mr. Dunn held a seat on
10 the Nacogdoches City Council for a decade, and he also served as
11 mayor and as Nacogdoches County judge; furthermore, he was
12 president of the Rotary Club of Nacogdoches and the Nacogdoches
13 County Chamber of Commerce; he lent his time and expertise to
14 numerous other organizations, including the American Legion and the
15 local VFW chapter; and

16 WHEREAS, A man of many talents, Mr. Dunn operated radio
17 stations KSFA-AM and FM92 from 1959 to 1989, and he was a longtime
18 sports announcer for Stephen F. Austin State University and
19 Nacogdoches High School; passionate about flying, he produced air
20 shows in Nacogdoches and the surrounding area for 40 years, and
21 local residents could often see his yellow and navy PT-19 circling
22 above the city; and

23 WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. Dunn enjoyed the love and
24 support of his wife, Nancy Raborn Dunn, with whom he shared a

1 rewarding marriage that spanned nearly six and a half decades; he
2 was the devoted father of three children, Elizabeth, Kathy, and
3 Jennifer, and he took great pride in his grandchildren; his family
4 and friends delighted in his country and western music
5 performances, and he was beloved for his boisterous laugh and
6 mastery of puns; a man of faith, he attended First Baptist
7 Nacogdoches; and

8 WHEREAS, Although Bob Dunn is deeply missed, he has left his
9 loved ones with a wealth of memories that they will forever
10 treasure; now, therefore, be it

11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas
12 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Bob Charles Dunn and
13 extend sincere condolences to all who mourn his passing; and, be it
