

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The citizens of Lubbock suffered a tragic loss when
2 Officer Nicholas Lee Reyna of the Lubbock Police Department was
3 killed in the line of duty on January 11, 2020, at the age of 27; and

4 WHEREAS, Born in San Angelo on October 9, 1992, Nick Reyna was
5 the son of Enrique Reyna and Sylvia Alaniz and grew up with four
6 siblings, Henry, Simon, Miranda, and Marissa; he was raised in
7 Colorado City, where he attended Colorado High School and was a
8 leader on the Fighting Wolves football team; following his
9 graduation, he enrolled at Angelo State University and earned his
10 bachelor's degree in accounting in 2018; and

11 WHEREAS, Officer Reyna embarked on his career in law
12 enforcement after completing his training at the Lubbock Police
13 Academy in April 2019; during his time with the Lubbock Police
14 Department, he worked as a patrol officer on the day shift, and his
15 dedicated efforts furthered the agency's mission of serving and
16 protecting the public; and

17 WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Officer Reyna was blessed with
18 the love and support of his wife, Christina; the couple met in high
19 school and married in October 2016, and together they were sharing
20 in the joy of raising their daughter, Catalina Isabelle; sustained
21 by a deep faith, Officer Reyna was a parishioner at Holy Spirit
22 Catholic Church; and

23 WHEREAS, Officer Nicholas Reyna's untimely death has brought
24 profound sorrow to all who were blessed to know this courageous law

1 enforcement professional, but his service and sacrifice in behalf
2 of his community will continue to be remembered and admired for many
3 years to come; now, therefore, be it

4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas
5 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Officer Nicholas Lee
6 Reyna and extend deepest condolences to his family, friends, and
7 colleagues; and, be it further

8 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
9 prepared for his family and that when the Texas House of
10 Representatives adjourns this day, it do so in memory of Nicholas
11 Reyna.
