2 Waxahachie were deeply saddened by his death on February 16, 2021,
3 at the age of 69; and

4 WHEREAS, Kirven White was born to J. H. and Oma White in
5 Bridgeport, Texas, on November 15, 1951, and he grew up with the
6 companionship of his sister, Gwenda, and his brother, Mick; and

7 WHEREAS, After graduating from high school, Mr. White
8 answered his nation's call to duty and enlisted in the United States
9 Army; he served in the 1st Cavalry Division during the Vietnam War
10 and was awarded numerous honors, including the Bronze Star Medal,
11 the Vietnam Service Medal with three Bronze Stars, and the National
12 Defense Service Medal; honorably discharged in 1975, he returned to
13 civilian life and began a career in sales with Breco Rental
14 Equipment; he retired from MIINC in 2013; and

15 WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. White enjoyed the love and
16 support of his wife, Dorothy, with whom he shared a rewarding union
17 that spanned more than four decades; he took great pride in his two
18 children, Brian and Kaleia, and with the passing years, he had the
19 pleasure of seeing his family grow to include a grandson, Brandon;
20 his favorite leisure activities included bowling and fishing, and
21 he especially treasured time spent with his loved ones; and

22 WHEREAS, Kirven White was a brave soldier, a caring husband,
23 and a devoted father, and he will forever be remembered with
24 admiration and affection by all those who were fortunate enough to

1 know him; now, therefore, be it
