R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The appointment of Pedro Criado as deputy chief of
2 the Fort Worth Police Department North Command presents a welcome
3 opportunity to pay tribute to his outstanding career in law
4 enforcement; and

5 WHEREAS, A native of Fort Worth, "Kiki" Criado joined FWPD in
6 1993; he is a former commander of the Northwest Division, and he has
7 served as a district lieutenant and as a sergeant in patrol, SWAT,
8 internal affairs, and public information; moreover, he was an
9 investigator for the Crimes Against Children Unit, a field training
10 corporal, and a patrol officer; and

11 WHEREAS, A leader in his profession, Deputy Chief Criado is
12 the commander of the Fort Worth Police Honor Guard and the first
13 treasurer of the Fort Worth chapter of the National Latino Peace
14 Officers Association; moreover, he is a former president of the
15 National Latino Law Enforcement Organization Fort Worth Chapter,
16 and he served as a co-chair of the Super Bowl XLV Joint Information
17 Center/PIO; he has also given generously of his time and talents to
18 Big Brothers Big Sisters Tarrant County, Chicano Luncheon, and
19 Hispano Éxito; and

20 WHEREAS, Among his many accolades, Deputy Chief Criado was
21 profiled by the Hispanic Heritage Board for Honor and Integrity in
22 2010, and he was named the 2014 Commander of the Year by the Fort
23 Worth Hispanic Chamber of Commerce; he holds a bachelor's degree
24 from Midwestern State University and a Master Peace Officer License

1 from the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement; in addition, he
2 completed the FBI-LEEDA Leadership Trilogy training and the City of
3 Fort Worth's Successful Supervision Training; and

4 WHEREAS, Through his hard work, professionalism, and
5 unwavering commitment to the safety and well-being of his fellow
6 Texans, Kiki Criado has set a standard of public service to which
7 others may aspire, and he may indeed reflect with pride on his many
8 achievements as he takes on the challenges and opportunities of his
9 new role; now, therefore, be it
