R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Since the beginning of the COVID-19 outbreak, the
2 Socorro Independent School District Board of Trustees has worked
3 tirelessly to foster a suitable learning environment and ensure the
4 health and well-being of area students; and

5 WHEREAS, The alarming scale of the pandemic has forced the
6 school district to adapt to rapidly changing circumstances over the
7 past year, including the closure of campuses, the introduction of
8 remote learning, and the implementation of safety protocols upon
9 reopening; tasked with setting policy and overseeing the operation
10 of school facilities, the Socorro ISD school board has carefully
11 considered public health guidelines while working with
12 administrators, educators, and parents to determine the most
13 efficient way for students to return to class; and

14 WHEREAS, The dedicated individuals presently serving on the
15 Socorro ISD Board of Trustees are president Cynthia Ann Najera,
16 vice president David O. Morales, secretary Paul Guerra, and members

21 schools across the country, the Socorro ISD Board of Trustees has
