4 WHEREAS, With the advent of full-time virtual learning and
5 hybrid schedules at local schools, YWCA El Paso del Norte Region has
6 stepped up to ensure that working parents had access to care for
7 their school-age children; in addition to educational camps, the
8 center has offered tutoring to assist students with distance
9 learning assignments; following federal guidelines, the
10 organization has implemented a wide range of health and safety
11 protocols, such as taking temperature readings, reducing classroom
12 ratios, requiring face masks, and increasing cleaning and
13 sanitation; and
