R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Lincoln Technical Institute is celebrating its 75th
2 anniversary in 2021, and this milestone presents a fitting
3 opportunity to recognize its Lincoln College of Technology campus
4 in Grand Prairie; and

5 WHEREAS, Incorporated under the laws of New Jersey in 1946,
6 Lincoln Technical Institute was initially dedicated to helping
7 World War II veterans transition into the workforce; today, Lincoln
8 Educational Services Corporation is a major provider of
9 diversified, career-oriented, postsecondary education; it offers
10 degree and diploma programs in health sciences, automotive
11 technology, skilled trades, hospitality services, and information
12 technology; across the country, it operates more than 20 campuses
13 in 14 states; and

14 WHEREAS, The Grand Prairie campus was initially established
15 in Dallas as Lincoln Technical Institute in 1966; early curricula
16 included automotive and diesel technology, and in 1974 instruction
17 in truck maintenance was added; the school moved to Grand Prairie in
18 1988, and three years later, it launched air conditioning and
19 refrigeration service courses; more recently, it has expanded to
20 offer training in such areas as welding and CNC machining, and it
21 created an associate's degree program in automotive technology; the
22 campus has been known as the Lincoln College of Technology since
23 2008; and

24 WHEREAS, For the past 75 years, Lincoln Technical Institute

1 has taught skills that prepare Americans for in-demand careers and
2 has helped to meet the ever-changing personnel requirements of
3 industry in an increasingly global economy; now, therefore, be it

4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas
5 Legislature hereby commemorate the 75th anniversary of Lincoln
6 Technical Institute and extend to all those associated with the
7 school and its Grand Prairie campus sincere best wishes for the
8 future; and, be it further

9 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
10 prepared for the institute as an expression of high regard by the
11 Texas House of Representatives.
