1 WHEREAS, Family and friends will long cherish their memories
2 of Ray Pace of McKinney, who passed away on March 23, 2021, at the
3 age of 79; and

4 WHEREAS, The son of Julian and Ruby Pace, Ray Pace was born on
5 September 17, 1941, in Abilene, and grew up with a brother, Julian;
6 after graduating from Waco High School in 1959, he attended Texas
7 Tech University and later received a bachelor's degree in business,
8 economics, and finance from Baylor University; and

9 WHEREAS, In 1962, Mr. Pace married the love of his life, the
10 former Sondra Kay Nelson, and they shared nearly six decades
11 together; he took great pride in his daughters, Karen and Keli, and
12 with the passing years, he had the pleasure of seeing his family
13 grow to include four grandchildren, Wyatt, Ty, Karis, and Kyle; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Pace worked for Blue Cross Blue Shield of Texas
15 for 13 years before founding The Pace Group, a health care
16 consulting firm; a valued member of his community, he served on the
17 boards of the Fellowship of Christian Athletes, Camp Fire,
18 Marketplace Ministries, and several area banks; to honor his wife's
19 volunteerism, he established the Sondra Nelson Pace Foundation,
20 which has supported several youth and Christian organizations; and

21 WHEREAS, Admired for his kindness and generosity, Ray Pace
22 lived a caring and purposeful life dedicated to his faith, his
23 family, and his friends, and he leaves behind a record of service
24 that his loved ones can remember with pride; now, therefore, be it
