20 support of his wife, Carol, and he took great pride in their
21 children, Katie, Josh, and Christina; with the passing years, he
22 had the pleasure of seeing his family grow to include four
23 grandchildren, Ellie, Max, Mikey, and Brayden; and

1 humor, Jim Kemp lived a caring and purposeful life, and he leaves
