2 memories of George Eric Cassity of Las Vegas, Nevada, who passed
3 away on September 6, 2020, at the age of 71; and

4 WHEREAS, Born in Ardmore, Oklahoma, on April 23, 1949, George
5 Cassity was the son of June and Martin Cassity; he enlisted in the
6 United States Marine Corps and completed two tours of duty in
7 Vietnam; after four years of service to his country, he was
8 honorably discharged at the rank of lance corporal; and

9 WHEREAS, Following his time in the military, Mr. Cassity made
10 his home in North Texas from the 1970s until the mid-1990s, during
11 which time he was employed as a credit manager and a truck driver;
12 in his later years, he contributed to several nonprofits, including
13 Catholic Charities, through his work as an accountant; he was a
14 gifted artist as well, and his work was included in a number of art
15 exhibitions; and

16 WHEREAS, Mr. Cassity was blessed with a treasured daughter,
17 Kate; he also enjoyed the companionship of his beloved cat, Zeppy;

20 always hold a special place in the hearts of those who held him
