(a) A state employee who is a volunteer of an 8 organization that is a member of the Texas Voluntary Organizations 9 10 Active in Disaster may be granted leave to participate in disaster relief services without a deduction in salary or loss of vacation 11 time, sick leave, earned overtime credit, or state compensatory 12 time if: 13 14 (1) the employee's supervisor authorizes the leave; 15 (2) the services in which the employee participates are provided for a state of disaster declared by the governor under 16 17 Chapter 418; and (3) the executive director of the employee's state 18 agency approves the leave. 19 (b) Leave granted to a state employee under Subsection (a) 20 may not exceed 10 days each fiscal year. 21 22 SECTION 2. Section 661.907, Government Code, is repealed. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021. 23
