| 8  | REPORT REQUIRED. (a) A peace officer has a duty to intervene to      |
| 9  | stop or prevent another peace officer from using excessive force     |
| 10 | against a person suspected of committing an offense if an ordinary,  |
| 11 | prudent peace officer would intervene under the same or similar      |
| 12 | circumstances.   |
| 13 | (b) A peace officer who witnesses the use of excessive force         |
| 14 | by another peace officer shall promptly make a detailed report of    |
| 15 | the incident and deliver the report to the supervisor of:            |
| 16 | (1) the peace officer making the report; and                         |
| 17 | (2) the peace officer who used the excessive force.                  |
| 18 | SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.                  |
