## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT relating to the inclusion of social and emotional skills in 2

3 character trait instruction provided by public schools.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Sections 29.906(a) and (b), Education Code, are 5
- amended to read as follows:

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- The State Board of Education shall integrate positive 7
- character traits, including social and emotional skills, into the 8
- essential knowledge and skills adopted for kindergarten through 9
- 10 grade 12, as appropriate.
- The State Board of Education must include the following 11
- 12 positive character traits and skills:
- 13 (1) courage;
- 14 (2) trustworthiness, including honesty, reliability,
- punctuality, and loyalty; 15
- (3) 16 integrity;
- 17 (4) respect and courtesy;
- including accountability, 18 (5) responsibility,
- diligence, perseverance, self-management skills, and self-control; 19
- (6) fairness, including justice and freedom from 20
- prejudice; 21
- 22 caring, including kindness, empathy, compassion,
- 23 consideration, patience, generosity, [and] charity, interpersonal
- 24 skills, and social awareness;

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- 1 (8) good citizenship, including patriotism, concern
- 2 for the common good and the community, responsible decision-making
- 3 skills, and respect for authority and the law;
- 4 (9) school pride; [and]
- 5 (10) gratitude; and
- 6 <u>(11)</u> self-awareness.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2021-2022
- 8 school year.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
