1-19 relating to certain county road reports.
 1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-21 SECTION 1. Section 251.018, Transportation Code, is
 1-22 repealed.
 1-23 SECTION 2. Section 256.104(a), Transportation Code, is
 1-24 amended to read as follows:
 1-25 (a) In applying for a grant under this subchapter, the
 1-26 county shall ~~+~~
 1-27 ~~[(1) provide the road condition report described by~~
 1-28 ~~Section 251.018 made by the county for the previous year; and~~
 1-29 ~~[(2)] submit to the department a plan that:~~
 1-30 (1) ~~[(A)]~~ provides a list of transportation
 1-31 infrastructure projects to be funded by the grant;
 1-32 (2) ~~[(B)]~~ describes the scope of the transportation
 1-33 infrastructure project or projects to be funded by the grant using
 1-34 best practices for prioritizing the projects;
 1-35 (3) ~~[(C)]~~ provides for matching funds as required by
 1-36 Section 256.105; and
 1-37 (4) ~~[(D)]~~ meets any other requirements imposed by the
 1-38 department.
 1-39 SECTION 3. Section 256.106(a), Transportation Code, is
 1-40 amended to read as follows:
 1-41 (a) A county that makes a second or subsequent application
 1-42 for a grant from the department under this subchapter must:
 1-43 (1) ~~[provide the department with a copy of a report~~
 1-44 ~~filed under Section 251.018;~~
 1-45 ~~[(2)]~~ certify that all previous grants are being spent
 1-46 in accordance with the plan submitted under Section 256.104; and
 1-47 (2) ~~[(3)]~~ provide an accounting of how previous grants
 1-48 were spent, including any amounts spent on administrative costs.
 1-49 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-50 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-51 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-52 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-53 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
