5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 773.011, Health and Safety Code, is
7	amended by amending Subsections (b) and (e) and adding Subsection
8	(d-1) to read as follows:
9	(b) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules
10	establishing minimum standards for the creation and operation of a
11	subscription program. The rules must:
12	(1) ensure the protection of public health and safety;
13	<u>and</u>
14	(2) for an air ambulance subscription program:
15	(A) ensure compliance with federal laws and rules
16	related to air ambulance subscription program services; and
17	(B) establish minimum standards and objectives
18	for the delivery of air ambulance emergency medical services
19	provided in accordance with a reciprocity agreement entered into
20	under Subsection (d-1).
21	(d-1) To ensure maximum geographic coverage for patients
22	covered under an air ambulance subscription program, an air
23	ambulance company that operates a subscription program in a service
24	delivery area shall, in accordance with executive commissioner

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- 1 rules, enter into a reciprocity agreement with each other air
- 2 ambulance company that operates a subscription program in that
- 3 <u>area.</u>
- 4 (e) The Insurance Code does not apply to a subscription
- 5 program established or a reciprocity agreement entered into under
- 6 this section.
- 7 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 8 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 9 Services Commission shall adopt rules necessary to implement
- 10 Section 773.011, Health and Safety Code, as amended by this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2022.
