- 8 (b) The comptroller shall notify a state agency purchasing a
- 9 good or service through a contract listed on a schedule developed
- 10 under this subchapter of the percentage used to calculate the
- 11 <u>rebate authorized under Subsection (a).</u>
- 12 (c) If a purchase resulting in a rebate under this section
- 13 is made in whole or in part with federal funds, the <u>purchasing state</u>
- 14 <u>agency</u> [comptroller] shall ensure that, to the extent the purchase
- 15 was made with federal funds, the appropriate portion of the rebate
- 16 is reported to [the purchasing agency for reporting and
- 17 reconciliation purposes with] the appropriate federal funding
- 18 agency.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
