5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 2002, Insurance Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 2002.007 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 2002.007. BUSINESS INTERRUPTION INSURANCE: PANDEMIC
8	COVERAGE. (a) In this section, "business interruption insurance"
9	means insurance coverage against lost income and certain operating
10	expenses caused by the policyholder being forced to vacate the
11	policyholder's business because of a loss covered by the policy.
12	(b) This section applies to each insurer that provides
13	business interruption insurance in this state, including a county
14	mutual insurance company, farm mutual insurance company, Lloyd's
15	plan, and reciprocal or interinsurance exchange.
16	(c) Business interruption insurance must cover loss caused
17	by a pandemic, including loss caused by the order of a civil
18	authority made to prevent the spread of a pandemic, without regard
19	to whether the pandemic caused a direct physical loss to the
20	policyholder's property.
21	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
22	to an insurance policy that is delivered, issued for delivery, or
23	renewed on or after January 1, 2022.
24	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
