- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. The Texas State Board of Public Accountancy
- 7 shall require each applicant for renewal of a license under
- 8 Subchapter I, Chapter 901, Occupations Code, to first comply with
- 9 the requirement of Section 901.169(a), Occupations Code, not later
- 10 than September 1, 2022. Notwithstanding Sections 901.169(a)(2)(E)
- 11 and 901.403(c), Occupations Code, an applicant for renewal of a
- 12 license is not required to comply with Section 901.169(a),
- 13 Occupations Code, until first required to by the board as provided
- 14 by this Act.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 22(d), Chapter 181 (H.B. 1520), Acts of
- 16 the 86th Legislature, Regular Session, 2019, is repealed.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
