## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 81.045, Health and Safety Code, is
7	amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
8	(d) If the department provides to a health authority, who
9	serves in that office part-time as described by Section 121.0245,
10	information on a death from a reportable or other communicable
11	disease reported to the department under this section, the
12	department shall also provide the information to the director of
13	the local health department for the county served by the health
14	authority.
15	SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 121, Health and Safety
16	Code, is amended by adding Section 121.0245 to read as follows:
17	Sec. 121.0245. DUTIES OF PART-TIME HEALTH AUTHORITY. (a)

- If a physician appointed to serve as health authority for a county 18
- 19 serves in that office part-time, the physician shall:
- (1) coordinate with the director of the local health 20
- 21 department for the county in the performance of the duties imposed
- by Section 121.024(c)(3); and 22
- 23 (2) notify the department that the physician serves
- 24 part-time in the office of health authority for the county.

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- 1 (b) If the department provides information to a physician
- 2 who serves part-time as health authority for a county, the
- 3 department shall also provide the information to the director of
- 4 the local health department for the county.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
