- SECTION 2. Subchapter G, Chapter 72, Government Code, is 16
- amended by adding Section 72.1221 to read as follows: 17
- 18 Sec. 72.1221. PROGRAM ACCESS TO FINANCIAL RECORDS. (a) To
- the extent allowed and in the manner required by federal law, a 19
- financial institution or other person, as applicable, shall on 20
- request provide the program with access to financial institution 21
- records, accounting records, and other financial records 22
- concerning a ward or the ward's estate, including receipts, records 23
- of deposits and withdrawals, invoices, bills, and any other records 24

- 8 <u>(c) After notice and a hearing, the court may issue an order</u>
- 9 requiring the financial institution or other person to provide the
- 10 records to the program under the conditions the court prescribes.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
