1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the creation of the urban air mobility advisory  
 1-20 committee.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 21, Transportation Code,  
 1-23 is amended by adding Section 21.004 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 21.004. URBAN AIR MOBILITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE. (a)  
 1-25 The commission shall appoint an advisory committee to assess  
 1-26 current state law and any potential changes to state law that are  
 1-27 needed to facilitate the development of urban air mobility  
 1-28 operations and infrastructure in this state.

1-29 (b) The commission shall appoint to the advisory committee  
 1-30 members to represent:

- 1-31 (1) diverse geographic regions of the state;
- 1-32 (2) state and local law enforcement;
- 1-33 (3) the urban air mobility industry;
- 1-34 (4) transportation experts;
- 1-35 (5) local governments; and
- 1-36 (6) the general public.

1-37 (c) The advisory committee shall:

- 1-38 (1) hold public hearings in locations across the state  
 1-39 or via electronic means; and
- 1-40 (2) receive comments through an Internet website, by  
 1-41 mail, and by other methods, if appropriate.

1-42 (d) Not later than September 1, 2022, the advisory committee  
 1-43 shall report to the commission and to the members of the legislature  
 1-44 the committee's findings and recommendations on any changes to  
 1-45 state law that are needed to facilitate the development of urban air  
 1-46 mobility operations and infrastructure.

1-47 (e) The advisory committee is abolished and this section  
 1-48 expires January 1, 2023.

1-49 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-50 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-51 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-52 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-53 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
