A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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- 2 relating to requiring sexually oriented businesses to participate
- 3 in the federal electronic verification of employment authorization
- 4 program, or E-verify; creating a criminal offense.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 51.016, Labor Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsections (a), (c), (d), (e), and (h) and adding
- 8 Subsection (j) to read as follows:
- 9 (a) In this section:

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- 10 (1) "E-verify program" has the meaning assigned by
- 11 <u>Section 673.001</u>, <u>Government Code</u>.
- 12 (2) "Sexually[, "sexually] oriented business" has the
- 13 meaning assigned by Section 243.002, Local Government Code.
- 14 (c) A sexually oriented business shall:
- 15 (1) maintain at the business a record that contains a
- 16 copy of a valid proof of identification of each employee or and
- 17 independent contractor working at the premises of the business; and
- 18 (2) register and participate in the E-verify program
- 19 to verify information of all employees and independent contractors.
- 20 (d) A proof of identification satisfies the requirements of
- 21 Subsection (c) $\underline{(1)}$ if the identification:
- 22 (1) contains a physical description and photograph
- 23 consistent with the person's appearance;
- 24 (2) contains the date of birth of the person; and

- 1 (3) was issued by a government agency.
- 2 (e) The form of identification under Subsection (c) (1) may
- 3 include:
- 4 (1) a driver's license issued by this state or another
- 5 state;
- 6 (2) a passport; or
- 7 (3) an identification card issued by this or another
- 8 state or the federal government.
- 9 (h) The commission, the attorney general, or a local law
- 10 enforcement agency may inspect a record maintained under this
- 11 section and request proof of E-verify program information
- 12 verification if there is good reason to believe that an individual
- 13 younger than 18 years of age is employed or has been employed by the
- 14 sexually oriented business within the two five years preceding the
- 15 date of the inspection.
- (j) A person commits an offense if the person fails to
- 17 register and participate in the E-verify program as required by
- 18 Subsection (c)(2).
- 19 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 20 to an employee of a sexually oriented business who commences
- 21 employment with the business on or after the effective date of this
- 22 Act.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
