1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to an exemption from the requirement that the title of a  
1-18 state agency be printed on state-owned motor vehicles.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section [721.003\(a\)](#), Transportation Code, is  
1-21 amended to read as follows:

1-22 (a) The governing bodies of the following state agencies or  
1-23 divisions by rule may exempt from the requirements of Section  
1-24 [721.002](#) a motor vehicle that is under the control and custody of the  
1-25 agency or division:

- 1-26 (1) Texas Commission on Fire Protection;
- 1-27 (2) Texas State Board of Pharmacy;
- 1-28 (3) Department of State Health Services and Department  
1-29 of Aging and Disability Services;
- 1-30 (4) Department of Public Safety of the State of Texas;
- 1-31 (5) Texas Department of Criminal Justice;
- 1-32 (6) Board of Pardons and Paroles;
- 1-33 (7) Parks and Wildlife Department;
- 1-34 (8) Railroad Commission of Texas;
- 1-35 (9) Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission;
- 1-36 (10) Texas Department of Banking;
- 1-37 (11) Department of Savings and Mortgage Lending;
- 1-38 (12) Texas Juvenile Justice Department;
- 1-39 (13) Texas Commission on Environmental Quality;
- 1-40 (14) Texas Lottery Commission;
- 1-41 (15) the office of the attorney general;
- 1-42 (16) Texas Department of Insurance; ~~and~~
- 1-43 (17) Texas Military Department; and
- 1-44 (18) an agency that receives an appropriation under an

1-45 article of the General Appropriations Act that appropriates money  
1-46 to the legislature.

1-47 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
