Section 38.001, Civil Practice and Remedies 18 Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to an award of attorney's 19 20 fees in an action commenced on or after the effective date of this Act. An award of attorney's fees in an action commenced before the 21 22 effective date of this Act is governed by the law applicable to the 23 award immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that

law is continued in effect for that purpose.
