6 SECTION 1. Section 16.053(h)(12), Water Code, is amended to

7 read as follows:

- 8 (12)Each regional water planning group and any committee or subcommittee of a regional water planning group is 9 10 [are] subject to Chapters 551 and 552, Government Code. A regional water planning group and any committee or subcommittee of the group 11 may hold an open or closed meeting by telephone conference call or 12 videoconference call. A meeting held by telephone conference call 13 is subject to the requirements of Sections 551.125(c), (d), (e), 14 and (f), Government Code. A meeting held by videoconference call is 15 subject to the requirements of Section 551.127, Government Code. 16
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 16.062(1), Water Code, is amended to 18 read as follows:
- (1) Each flood planning group and <u>any</u> committee or subcommittee of a flood planning group is subject to Chapters 551 and 552, Government Code. <u>A flood planning group and any committee</u> or subcommittee of the group may hold an open or closed meeting by telephone conference call or videoconference call. A meeting held by telephone conference call is subject to the requirements of

- 1 Sections 551.125(c), (d), (e), and (f), Government Code. A meeting
- 2 <u>held by videoconference call is subject to the requirements of</u>
- 3 <u>Section 551.127</u>, Government Code.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
