1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the inspection of municipal buildings during a declared
 1-22 disaster.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 214, Local Government
 1-25 Code, is amended by adding Section 214.220 to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 214.220. INSPECTION DURING DECLARED DISASTER. (a) In
 1-27 an area of a municipality that is subject to a declaration of
 1-28 disaster by the governor under Chapter 418, Government Code, or a
 1-29 declaration of local disaster under that chapter, a building
 1-30 inspection for compliance with this subchapter or related municipal
 1-31 regulations may, while the declaration is in effect, be performed
 1-32 by:

1-33 (1) a person certified to inspect buildings by the
 1-34 International Code Council;

1-35 (2) a person employed as a building inspector by the
 1-36 municipality in which the building is located; or

1-37 (3) a person employed as a building inspector by any
 1-38 political subdivision, if the municipality in which the building is
 1-39 located has approved the person to perform inspections during a
 1-40 disaster.

1-41 (b) A municipality may not collect an additional inspection
 1-42 fee related to the inspection of a building performed under
 1-43 Subsection (a).

1-44 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-45 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-46 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-47 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-48 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
