## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the time in which early voting is conducted.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 12.004(d), Election Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (d) If early voting by personal appearance is required to be
- 7 conducted for extended hours under Section 85.005(c) or for weekend
- 8 hours under Section  $85.006[\frac{(e)}{(e)}]$ , the registrar's office shall
- 9 remain open for providing voter registration information during the
- 10 extended hours or weekend hours that the main early voting polling
- 11 place is open for voting.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 85.001(e), Election Code, is amended to
- 13 read as follows:
- 14 (e) For an election held on the uniform election date in
- 15 May, or for [and] any [resulting] runoff election resulting from an
- 16 <u>election held on a uniform election date</u>, the period for early
- 17 voting by personal appearance begins on the 12th day before
- 18 election day and continues through the fourth day before election
- 19 day.
- SECTION 3. Section 85.005(c), Election Code, is amended to
- 21 read as follows:
- 22 (c) The [In a county with a population of 100,000 or more,
- 23 the] voting in a primary election or the general election for state
- 24 and county officers shall be conducted at the main early voting

- 1 polling place for [at least] 12 hours on each weekday of the last
- 2 week of the early voting period, and the voting in a special
- 3 election ordered by the governor shall be conducted at the main
- 4 early voting polling place for [at least] 12 hours on each of the
- 5 last two days of the early voting period. Unless ordered by a court,
- 6 voting time shall be not more than 12 hours in one day [Voting shall
- 7 be conducted in accordance with this subsection in those elections
- 8 in a county with a population under 100,000 on receipt by the early
- 9 voting clerk of a written request for the extended hours submitted
- 10 by at least 15 registered voters of the county. The request must be
- 11 submitted in time to enable compliance with Section 85.067].
- SECTION 4. Section 85.006(b) and (d), Election Code, are
- 13 amended to read as follows:
- 14 (b) In an election in which a county clerk or city secretary
- 15 is the early voting clerk under Section 83.002 or 83.005, the hours
- 16 for voting shall be as follows:
- 17 (1) on any weekday of the first week of the early
- 18 voting period, from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m.;
- 19 (2) on a Saturday during the early voting period, from
- 20 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.;
- 21 (3) on a Sunday during the early voting period, from
- 22 1:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m.; and
- 23 (4) on any weekday of the last week of the early voting
- 24 period, from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. [only the early voting clerk
- 25 may order voting on a Saturday or Sunday. The clerk must do so by
- 26 written order.
- 27 (d) The authority authorized to order early voting on a

- 1 Saturday or Sunday under Subsection (a) [or (b)] shall order the
- 2 voting under the applicable subsection on receipt of a written
- 3 request submitted by at least 15 registered voters of the territory
- 4 covered by the election. The request must be submitted in time to
- 5 enable compliance with Section 85.007. The authority is not
- 6 required to order the voting on a particular date specified by the
- 7 request but shall order the voting on at least one Saturday if a
- 8 Saturday is requested and on at least one Sunday if a Sunday is
- 9 requested.
- 10 SECTION 5. Section 85.064(d), Election Code, is amended to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 (d) The authority authorized under Section 85.006 to order
- 13 early voting on a Saturday or Sunday may also order, in the manner
- 14 prescribed by that section, early voting to be conducted on a
- 15 Saturday or Sunday at any one or more of the temporary branch
- 16 polling places. [In addition, the early voting clerk of a county
- 17 covered by Section 85.006(e) shall order such voting in accordance
- 18 with that subsection at each temporary branch polling place
- 19 established under Section 85.062(d).
- SECTION 6. Sections 85.006(c) and (e), Election Code, are
- 21 repealed.
- 22 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
