 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the authorized activities of a holder of a brewpub
 1-22 license.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 74.01, Alcoholic Beverage Code, as
 1-25 effective September 1, 2021, is amended by amending Subsection (a)
 1-26 and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:

1-27 (a) A holder of a brewpub license for a brewpub located in a
 1-28 wet area, as that term is described by Section 251.71, may:

1-29 (1) brew, bottle, can, package, and label malt
 1-30 beverages;

1-31 (2) sell or offer without charge, on the premises of
 1-32 the brewpub, to ultimate consumers for consumption on or off those
 1-33 premises, malt beverages produced by the holder, in or from a lawful
 1-34 container, to the extent the sales or offers are allowed under the
 1-35 holder's other permits or licenses; ~~and~~

1-36 (3) sell food on the premises of the holder's
 1-37 breweries; and

1-38 (4) conduct samplings of malt beverages, including
 1-39 tastings, at a retailer's premises.

1-40 (a-1) An agent or employee of the holder of a brewpub
 1-41 license may open, touch, or pour malt beverages, make a
 1-42 presentation, or answer questions at a sampling event.

1-43 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
