16	(A) a district or county attorney; or			
17	(B) a county employee who:			
18	(i) serves as the head of the civil legal			
19	department of a county located on the international border that has			
20	a population of less than 400,000 and contains one or more			
21	municipalities with a population of 200,000 or more; and			
22	(ii) has received approval for the			
23	submission of the request from the commissioners court of the			
24	county.
